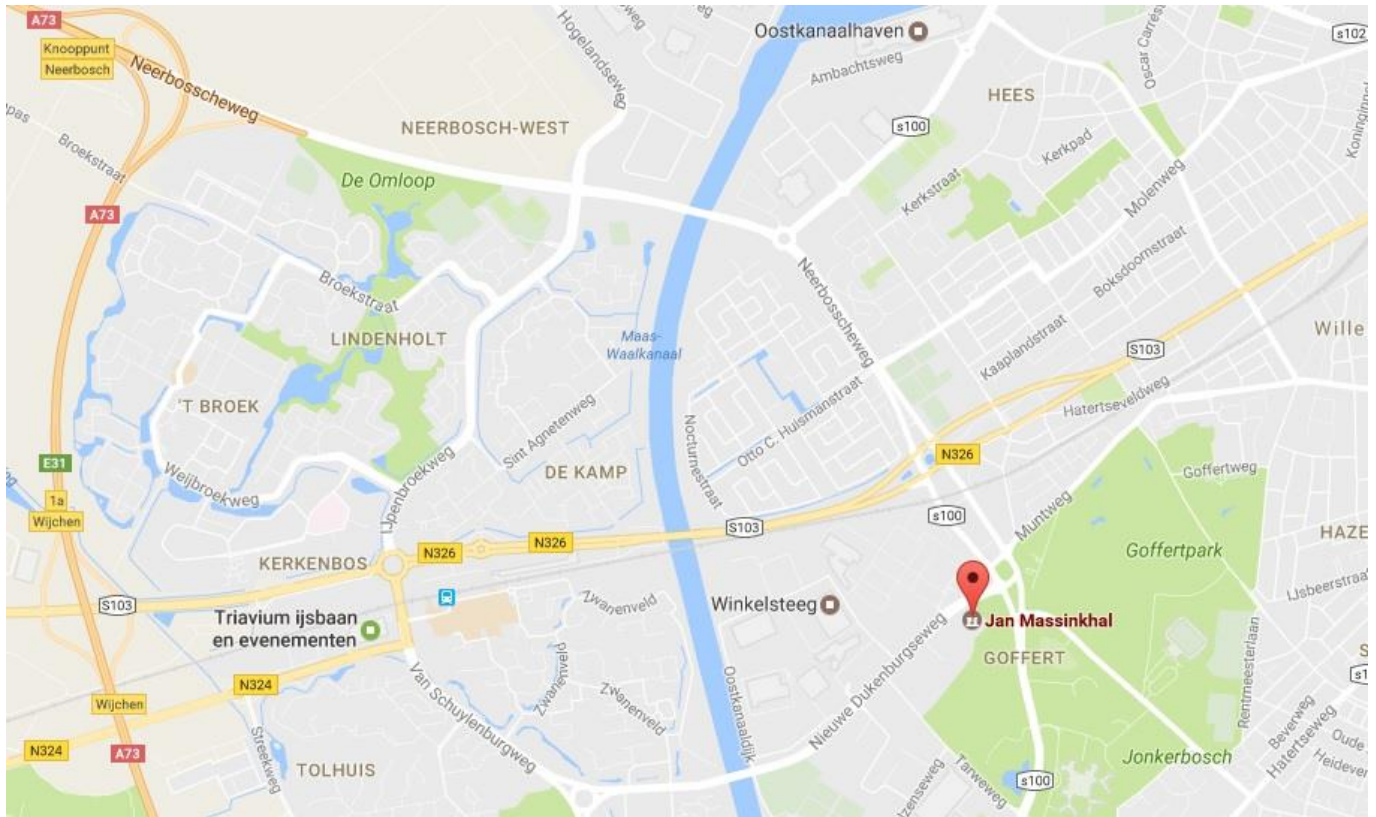
Timekeeping
